

## WHAT TO DO IF YOUR POWER IS INTERRUPTED:

Check your circuit breakers. If they're OK,  
call us immediately at any of the following numbers:

**Call CEC if you have a power outage.  
Keep trying if the lines are busy.**

- 1.** In the unlikely event of a downed power line, **DO NOT** attempt to move it or touch it! Call CEC or the police. Professional, highly trained personnel will respond immediately.
- 2. DO NOT** plug portable home electric generators into a wall outlet. Our servicemen could be **FATALLY** injured by the backfeed of electricity through your home's electrical system.
- 3. Unplug Major Appliances** - Switch off or disconnect the big energy consumers such as your stove, heat pump, water heater, freezer, hot tub, furnace fan and refrigerator. All of these appliances demand a sudden surge of energy when we restore power to your home.
- 4. Gradually Turn on Major Appliances** - After power is restored to your home, wait one-half hour before turning on any major appliances. Then start turning on one major appliance spaced over 15 minutes periods.
- 5.** If some of your lights appear to be dim when the power comes back on, call CEC.
