AGRICULTURAL IRRIGATION RATE SCHEDULE C-1

APPLICABLE

Applicable to all agricultural irrigation pumping applications in excess of 10 horsepower of member's aggregate load.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Alternating current, single phase, 60 cycles at available secondary voltage. Pump motors having a rated capacity in excess of 10 HP must be three phase.

RATE

ENERGY CHARGE - ALL KWH

All KWH per month @ 5.42¢ per KWH

DEMAND CHARGE –

\$3.50 per KW demand for month

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

Demand measurement will be made by suitable instruments at the point of delivery where reasonably practicable; where metering is impracticable, such demands shall be estimated from the connected load and method of operation of the pumping equipment on the basis of suitable field tests. Demand, where indicated or recorded by demand meter, shall be defined as the average kilowatt delivery during the 15 minute period in which consumption of energy is greatest during the month for which the bill is rendered.

LINE EXTENSION POLICY

Whenever it is necessary to install new distribution facilities, extend or reinforce existing distribution facilities, the rates and charges above are subject to the provisions of the Central Electric Cooperative, Inc., "Line Extension Policy."

REACTIVE POWER CHARGE

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kilovolt-amperes in excess of 40% of the measured kilowatt demand for the same month will be billed, in addition to the above charges, at 60¢ per kvar of such excess reactive demand.
