INDUSTRIAL SERVICE RATE SCHEDULE F

APPLICABLE

Applicable to all industrial power customers. Energy supplied under this schedule shall not be sub-metered for resale or resold to others.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Alternating current, three phase, 60 cycles at available secondary voltage. Includes temporary service to construction projects and other such temporary loads as specified in the CEC General Service Rate Schedule B. A CEC customer shall qualify for the Industrial Service Rate if the customer's average of the two greatest non-zero monthly demands established during the 12 month period exceeds 350 KW.

RATE

ENERGY CHARGE

First 15,000 KWH per month @ 5.11¢ per KWH
15,001 - 400,000 KWH per month @ 3.65¢ per KWH
Over 400,000 KWH per month @ 3.15¢ per KWH

DEMAND CHARGE

First 15 KW of demand per month - No Charge
Over 15 KW of demand per month - \$3.00 per KWD

FACILITIES CHARGE

Three Phase, 350 KW and above - \$65.00 per month

MINIMUM CHARGE

The net minimum charge will be the above customer charge plus \$2.40 per KVA of installed transformer capacity above 15 KVA.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

Demand measurement will be made by suitable instruments at the point of delivery. Demand for any month shall be defined as the average kilowatt delivery during the 15 minute period in which consumption of energy is greatest during the month for which the bill is rendered.

LINE EXTENSION POLICY

Whenever it is necessary to install new distribution facilities, extend or reinforce existing distribution facilities, the rates and charges above are subject to the provisions of the Central Electric Co-op "Line Extension Policy."

REACTIVE POWER CHARGE

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kilovolt-amperes in excess of 40% of the measured kilowatt demand for the same month will be billed, in addition to the above charges, at 60¢ per kvar of such excess reactive demand.
